

# Sno Kone Machine Operation

1. Make certain you have all the necessary components: Sno Kone machine, drip-tray with tube, and ice-scoop. If you have chosen such, there should also be a bucket (to catch the melt-water).
2. Place the Sno Kone machine on top of the drip-tray on a level and stable surface near to your power source.
3. Plug the Sno Kone machine in.
4. Turn on the light switch (if you desire).
5. Fill the hopper (on the top of the machine) to within an inch of the top with ice cubes or block ice (no larger than 4 inches across).
6. While applying firm and steady pressure on the pusher handle, press and hold the red Motor Switch. Releasing the Motor Switch will stop the motor. Apply firm and even pressure to make the best “snow”. You may find that you need to relieve the pressure on the ice a few times during the cycle. Too much pressure will result in snow that is coarse; too little pressure will make for “slushy” snow.
7. When you’ve finished with the Sno Kone machine, turn off the light switch and unplug the machine. You may return it dirty (it’s our job to make sure it’s clean).

**Note: Never allow limbs or any foreign objects near the shaver area of the Sno Kone machine. Aside from the danger to you, this may cause harm to the machine.**
